HENRIETTA ISD ATHILETIC CODE OF CONDUCT

DRUGS, ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, AND VAPING

A. All athletes must enter the random drug testing program at Henrietta ISD. All athletes are bound by the rules and regulations of the Henrietta ISD Drug testing policy.

- B. Alcohol, tobacco, and vaping use will be dealt with as follows:
 - 1) For the first infraction, the athlete will serve a 1 game suspension and will be assigned extra discipline.
 - 2) The second infraction will result in the athlete serving a 2 game suspension along with extra discipline.
 - 3) Third infraction will result in permanent removal of the athletic program for 1 calendar year.
- C. Arrests made outside of school for alcohol or drug related cases:
 - 1) First infraction, the athlete will be dealt with in the same manner as if they were caught on a drug test at school. In the case of alcohol the athlete will be dealt with in the same manner as in the alcohol, tobacco, and vaping policy above for a first infraction.
 - 2) Multiple outside infractions will result in the removal of the athlete from the program for 1 calendar year.

GENERAL RULES

A. Missing Practice

As a member of any Henrietta ISD team, you are expected to be at every practice and meeting. If there is an emergency and you cannot attend practice, you must let your coach know as soon as possible. You must call your coach, otherwise, your absence will be unexcused.

B. Late to Practice

Be on time to all practices so the team can stay on their practice schedule.

C. Grades

You are in school to earn an education. You must meet all UIL eligibility requirements in order to participate.

D. Conduct

As athletes, you are in the spotlight. Be respectful to others and conduct yourself with class at all times during school. Time spent in AEP or detention will be considered unexcused absences.



E. Out-of-town Trips

We represent the City of Henrietta and Henrietta High School. Do not do anything to embarrass your-self, your teammates, your school, or your town. Students who participate in school-sponsored trips are required to ride in transportation provided by the school to and from the event. An exception will be made if the student's parents/legal guardian personally requests that the student be allowed to ride home with the parent and arrangements are made with the head coach along with a note. The district is not liable for any injuries that occur to students riding in vehicles that are not provided by the school.

F. Sportsmanship

Treat game officials with respect at all times. Play clean and fair.

G. Equipment

The equipment you use is the property of Henrietta ISD. Take care of it all times. Equipment is not allowed to leave the school/field house without your coach's permission. Any lost or stolen equipment will be paid for.

H. Appearance

All athletes will be well groomed. Male athletes will not be allowed to have facial hair, and males are not allowed to wear earrings are not allowed to be worn during the athletic period, practice, and at athletic events during the school year. All athletes are expected to set the standard for the school dress code.

I. Profanity

Profanity will not be tolerated.

J. Playing a Team Sport

If you desire to play a team sport, you must be enrolled in the athletic period at the beginning of the school year and participate in our strength and conditioning program.

K. Starting a Sport

If you desire to play a sport, you must join the team at the beginning of the season. Only exception is one who moves into school after the season has begun.

J. Quitting

We desire for athletes to learn the value of finishing what they start. If an athlete quits one sport, they will not be allowed to start the next sport until the completion of the sport they quit has finished. Re-entry into a sport they quit will be at the discretion of the Athletic Director and the head coach of that sport.



K. Social Media

We desire for athletes to learn the value of expressing themselves in respectful manner. Carefully consider how you represent yourself on your social media outlets. Everything you post is public information. We will not tolerate disrespectful comments and behavior on social media outlets. This includes but is not limited to derogatory remarks that may harm teammates, coaches, fellow student athletes, teachers, administrators, or representatives of other schools. This also includes but is not limited to incriminating photos or statements depicting violence, hazing, sexual harassment, full or partial nudity, inappropriate gestures, vandalism, stalking, underage drinking, usage of tobacco, vaping, underage use of alcohol, and the selling, possessing, or using controlled substances, or any other inappropriate behaviors.
